Call for abstracts and papers

Abstracts will be received until February 28 and full papers should reach the Organizing Committee by April 15, This will provide time to prepare the final programme and also the Conference Proceedings in time for the Symposium.

Abstracts should not exceed 100 words. There is no set format for the prepare. However, they should be presented on a ready to print copy, and should not exceed 15 pages. Papers through E-mail will be accepted. Facilities for slides, transparencies and audiovisual (Betamax and VHS) will be provided.
